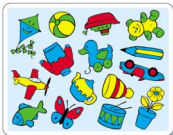
Players: 2 – 8 • Age: 5+ • Playing Time: Approx. 15 min.

Contents:

15 picture plates

Each plate shows the same 15 items : Teddy bear, duck, pencil, pullover, flower, ship, plane, cap, ball, teapot, drum, fish, butterfly, car, kite.

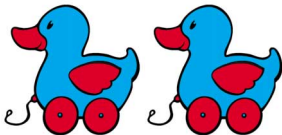
Every item is two-coloured, but the exact combination varies. So the teddy is sometimes yellow-green, sometimes green-yellow, sometimes red-blue etc.



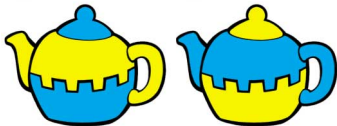
Idea of the game

Two picture plates are turned over and put in the centre of the table. No matter which two plates are picked and turned over, **one, and only one, item** on one of the plates will always be absolutely identical to one item on the other plate. Never more than one, but always one. To find this item as quickly as possible is what the game is about.

absolutely identical



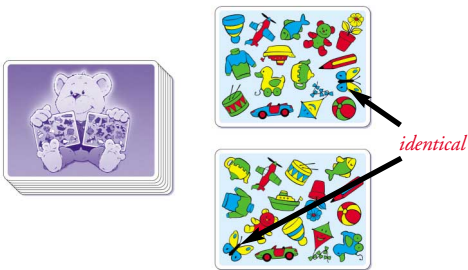
not identical

Whoever has the most plates at the end wins the game.

How to play

The 15 picture plates are shuffled and put at the edge of the table as a face-down stock. The oldest player takes the top two plates off the stock and puts them in the centre of the table face up, with a little space between them – and the game begins!

One item is absolutely identical on both plates. **All players** look for that item **at the same time**. A player who thinks he has found the item quickly calls out its name and points it out to the other players.

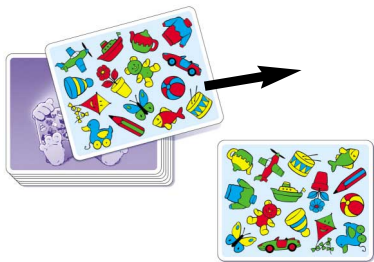


Nadine has found the identical item and quickly calls: "butterfly". For control, she points at the two identical butterflies.

The player who first correctly called the name of the identical item takes one of the two picture plates as a prize and puts it face down in front of himself.

Note: If a player names a wrong item, he must pause for this round; the other players keep on looking until one of them has found the right item.

Then the player who named the right item (and won the plate) takes the top plate off the stock and puts it face up next to the remaining one. The game goes on!



After Nadine has taken one of the two plates as a prize and put it face down in front of herself, she turns over the top card of the stock and puts it in the position of the prize.

And on it goes: Everybody once more looks for the identical item at the same time.

Note: When a player takes a picture plate as a prize, he should always take the one that has been on the table longer. So, if the top plate was taken as a prize in one round, you should take the bottom one in the next round, then the top one again, and so on.

End of the game

The game goes on until the stock is used up and there is only one plate left in the centre of the table. Whoever has the most picture plates wins the game. Should more than one player have the highest number of plates, they are all winners.
